The year in review was discussed by Julia. The full description is available in the Annual Member Packet. Topics not included in the packet include:

Storage areas for boats will be doubled in early 2025. Long term marina parking, unless you are a winner of the slip lottery, is not allowed. Tom Bolte made a motion to drop the crappie limit from 15 to 10, Doug August seconded and the motion carried. Dredging of a cove at 1633 Lakeshore will need a survey to check on responsibility.

The budget for the next fiscal year was voted on and approved.

Mike Garloch gave an update on the treatment facility. It should be completed by summer. Water rates will not increase for 2 years. The boost station should be completed by end of May.

Current by-laws state that the board would meet on the 3rd Friday of the month. Julia Baker motioned to change it to the 3rd Monday, Brian Tharp seconded and the motion passed. Will check on the possibility of doing zoom meetings for members who cannot make meetings.

Two changes made: solar panels will be roof mounted only for those who choose to go solar. The rule violation fees are now scheduled, not just a flat fee.
