Water board positions open

The Public Water Supply District (PWSD) #1 has 1 to 2 board member openings every year. If there is more than one candidate, there is an election held in April. If there are no candidates and the current candidate(s) are willing to remain in office, no election is required.

The PWSD is comprised of 5 subdistricts. Subdistricts 3 and 4 are the upcoming board member openings. Candidates can apply at the PWSD office (at the PVL lodge). To be eligible to apply, you must be a registered voter in Gasconade County and a full-time resident of Peaceful Valley Lake. While there is no salary, board members can qualify to receive \$100 for each monthly board meeting they attend. To qualify, board members must complete certification training.

Member Survey – Those receiving this newsletter via email will receive a member survey from the Board to assist with planning and budgeting for 2024 – and beyond. You can also pick one up at the Lodge, or find it on the website. Thank you, in advance, for participating! Your input matters.

Roads – Good news is, the same contractor who handled SNOW REMOVAL last year is engaged again. Look forward to fast and competent snow removal for the winter months.

A lawncare and LEAF REMOVAL contractor has also been engaged, so expect ditch leaf removal to begin, saving clogged drainage culverts and a burden of leaves ending up in the lake.

Road MAINTENANCE in 2023 was delayed for expected heavy equipment traffic to the Wastewater Treatment Facility. Since that project was delayed, 2023 funding for roads will be added to 2024 funding, enabling road work to begin in mid to late summer when the major phase of the facility construction will have been completed.

Security gate project – The first evidence will be Lake Road, off Woodson Drive, blocked with a gate that will allow authorities and utilities entrance with a standard key. Other traffic will have to go to Hwy. Y, the lower gate.

You will also see construction at the lower entrance, beginning with new concrete work. The board expects to have the lower entrance system installed early in the year. In the meantime, you will be notified of multiple ways to access the lake area, including: a "fob" for proximity sensing; personal
